

dj check **up**

Music will be one of the most important parts of your **wedding celebration**.

Here are some suggestions to assist you in selecting and **hiring a DJ**.

- 1.** Is the DJ's business professionally operated?
- 2.** If the DJ is using reproductions (copies) of sound recordings stored on a computer hard drive or copied onto CD-R's, mini-discs or cassettes, does the DJ have an AVLA licence, either directly with AVLA or through an AVLA-licensed DJ Association such as CODJA?
- 3.** Does the DJ offer a written agreement?
- 4.** Does the agreement state what time the DJ will start and finish performing and the time the DJ will arrive on site to set up?
- 5.** Is there a "back-up" DJ and equipment if there is a last minute problem?
- 6.** Have you met the DJ who will actually be playing the music at your wedding, prior to the wedding day?
